LIFT is seeking submissions of current members' films for a screening to be held at the Hot Docs Ted Rogers Cinema on **Thursday, July 20, 2017**

REQUIREMENTS:

- Accepted genres: narrative, documentary, animation, experimental, music videos
- Commercials and PSAs cannot be submitted
- Maximum running time is 8 minutes (including credits)
- Work must have been completed in 2016 or 2017
- Work must have been made by a *current member in good standing* as of May 23, 2017
- Member must have used LIFT production equipment and facilities in the creation of the work
- Work may be shot in either film or video/digital

Artist fees will be paid.
