LIFT exists to provide support and encouragement for independent filmmakers and artists through affordable access to production, post-production and exhibition equipment; professional and creative development; workshops and courses; commissioning and exhibitions; artist residencies; and a variety of other services. LIFT requires a highly organized summer **Conference and Meeting Planner** to join the LIFT staff and to work in cooperation with the Special Projects Manager to support the **Canada Media Arts Skills Exchange** at the end of May and further summer programming.

#### **BASIC REQUIREMENTS:**

- Between 18 and 30 years of age (inclusive)
- A Canadian citizen or permanent resident or person on whom refugee protection has been conferred under the Immigration and Refugee Protection Act
- Is legally entitled to work according to the relevant provincial / territorial legislation and regulations

- A strong desire to work in an artist-run media production centre is an asset

# RESPONSIBILITIES WILL INCLUDE A COMBINATION OF THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES:

- Support of the Special Project Manager in planning, administering and executing a four-day long event for approximately forty people, including logistics, hotel bookings and project management.
- Coordinating with filmmakers and LIFT to make sure project needs are met.
- Tracking project budgets and timelines to ensure programs are delivered on time and within budget
- Conference/meeting design and implementation



- Manage artist relations and communications pertaining to travel and presentations
- Screenings and Outreach Events

## QUALIFICATIONS INCLUDE:

This position requires the ability to multi-task in a fast-paced work environment. Summer staff often collaborate in a number of aspects of the day-to-day operations.

### The ideal candidate will have some of the following qualifications:

- Knowledge of the Macintosh platform
- Knowledge of project planning and budgeting and event management.
- Experience developing and delivering arts programming
- The ideal candidate is a self-directed team-worker, who is detail oriented
- The candidate should have a strong interest in media art and be committed to supporting independent media in all its forms

- Knowledge of analogue filmmaking and darkroom processes
- Experience using social media (Facebook, Instagram, X/Twitter and Canva) for outreach
- Knowledge of media arts production workflows and technology across all film, digital and new media genres and production models
